LITTER POLICY

The council will:

- endeavour to inform and assist in the reduction of litter in the village
- maintain a stock of a number of litter pickers, together with equipment to hold the litter bags and the bags themselves.
- ensure that a record is kept of when any equipment is borrowed, and when it is returned.
- ensure volunteer litter pickers are provided with a copy of a risk assessment and guidance on litter picking
- support initiatives to stop or reduce litter in the village, subject to any funding requirement being agreed at a council meeting
- employ a person to collect litter for four hours a week, with two hours worked on a weekend, unless agreed otherwise by council.
- focus litter picking on Merthyr Road, between Greenmeadow Springs and the Tongwynlais sign to the north of the village, and on Mill Road and Castle Road, up to the entrance to Castell Coch and on other streets that may be agreed from time to time.
- arrange and support group litter picking on dates to be agreed
- undertake initiatives to reduce and stop dog fouling in the village
- report incidences of dog fouling to CCC for clearance
